

## Analog Output Call Recording (no PC) for Norstar/BCM/Meridian 1 Telephones

Voice conversations may be recorded at the desktop (using a tape recorder and without a PC) regardless of whether using a handset, headset, or hands-free. In this application the 4100 AuxBox converts the digital voice messages to analog for connection to a desktop voice recorder.

Conversations may be recorded automatically – either by using the "VOX" function of the tape recorder or preferably by connecting the AuxBox off-hook detection relay into the "REMOTE" input of the tape recorder. Alternately, the recorder could be activated by pressing the "Record" button anytime that a conversation needs to be recorded, such as for an important conference call.

Most inexpensive consumer tape recorders available at retail electronics stores will be compatible with the AuxBox audio output.
