

T7406 Analog Output Desktop Voice Recording

This Application Note describes a method for recording calls with an analog recording device, such as a desktop tape recorder or a multi-channel analog voice recorder.

The 4100 AuxBox monitors the digital signaling between the T7406 base station and KSU/BCM. Digital speech data is recovered and provided as an analog output from a jack on the AuxBox. A relay output is also provided to indicate that the telephone is in-use which can be used to start and stop recording.

Requirements

- 4100 AuxBox
- Voice Recorder and Audio Cord (customer supplied)
