Algo's FXO, FXS, and SIP Doorphones provide hands free intercom capability, entrance security with door unlock control, and superior audio performance.

These Doorphones are perfect for secure business entrances, emergency intercom, and residential gates. Visitors press a backlit call button on the two wire Door Station to initiate ring on one more telephones. Answering the ringing phone enables communication with the visitor and door unlock capability.

Each Algo Doorphone kit is comprised of a **Door Station**, typically located outdoors, and a separate indoor **Controller**. The **Controller** provides the telephone system interface and also adds door unlock control.



3226 Trunk Port FXO Doorphone

The 3226 emulates a Central Office (CO) telephone line, allowing it to connect directly to a FXO Gateway or telephone system analog trunk port. Configurable ring cadence and CLID message.



3228 Station Port FXS Doorphone

The 3228 emulates an analog telephone set, allowing it to connect to an FXS gateway or telephone system analog station port. Configurable for hotline or extension dialing.



8028 SIP Doorphone

The 8028 emulates a SIP telephone for compatibility with most SIP servers, and supports PoE.
