

ALGO DEVICE MANAGEMENT PLATFORM (ADMP) FEATURE UPDATE

Algo has introduced several new updates to the Algo Device Management Platform. Updates include new features and bug fixes. Changes made will have no impact on typical functionality and will not require any downtime. Additional details on the new features are outlined below:

Simplified First-Time Device Configuration

 Algo IP endpoints no longer need to be manually monitored in the ADMP. When a device connects to the ADMP for the first time, the Algo device will immediately be Monitored and show up in the *Monitored* tab (provided there are enough licenses available).

Simplified Device License State

 The concept of activated/de-activated devices has been removed and is now merged into Unmonitored. Devices can now only be either Monitored or Unmonitored. When an Algo device is Monitored, it will use up a license. If the device is Unmonitored, it will no longer use up a license and the ADMP will be unable to identify the state of the device until it is Monitored again.

Sorting Tags / No Tags

• The ability to sort by tags / no tags has been included. Clicking on the Tags column will sort the devices with or without tags.
